Valedictory of the Human Rights Training Programs for Lawyers

The Bar Council of Tamil Nadu and the Institute of Human Rights Education of People's Watch - Tamil Nadu are extremely happy to inform you that the Valedictory Function of our Human Rights Training Programs for Lawyers jointly conducted by us throughout the State. Programs were held on 15th and 16th of July, 2005 at Madurai, on 30th and 31st July at Trichy, on 6th & 7th August at Tindivanam and thereafter on 13th & 14th August at Tanjore and on 20th & 21st August at Coimbatore. The first phase of the trainings culminated in Courtallam on 27th & 28th August, 2005. After the completion of the Bar Council of Tamil Nadu elections, the training programs resumed under the Chairmanship of Mr. K.Chandramohan and were conducted at Salem on 7th & 8th January, 2006, at Vellore on 22nd & 23rd January and at Chennai on 4th & 5th February, 2006. The 9 programs in all had a total number of 1,680 participants comprising 1,547 men and 133 women.

His Lordship, Mr. Justice Ajit Prakash Shah, the Chief Justice of the Madras High Court has kindly consented to deliver the Valedictory Address in the Valedictory Function to be held on **1st April, 2006 at 3.00 p.m. at the auditorium of Bishop Heber College, in Tiruchirapalli.** His Lordship the Chief Justice of the Madras High Court will be accompanied by 7 of the Senior Judges of the Madras High Court to this function namely, **Mr Justice M. Karpaga Vinayagam, Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam, Mr. Justice P.K. Misra, Mr. Justice R. Balasubramanian, Mr. Justice P.D. Dinakaran, Mr. Justice Elipe Dharma Rao, Mr. Justice F.M. Ibrahim Kalifulla,** and we are also expecting all the Members of the Bar Council of Tamil Nadu led by the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and all India Bar Council Member also to participate in this program. **Mr. Justice H. Suresh, a Retired Judge of the Mumbai High Court and a Member of the Indian People's Tribunal** will also be delivering a special address at this valedictory function.
